Checks are to be made payable to the Borough of State College.

On January 22, 2011, Pennsylvania Act 106 went into effect. This no longer allows vendors of Farmer's Markets to be under one Retail Food Outlet License.

Each vendor operating at a farmer's market must supply a valid copy of a Retail Food License from the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture or a local Eating and Drinking or Retail Outlet License. This application must be filled out and returned to the Department of Ordinance Enforcement and Public Health with a copy of a valid license. If a valid license is not held then approval along with the form and a fee of \$115 must be submitted prior to operation. The only exemption from licensing is raw agricultural commodities (produce, flowers, plants).
